

What is project based learning?

- A teaching method in which children gain knowledge and skills by working for an extended period of time to investigate and respond to an authentic, and complex question, problem, or challenge.
- The project is the vehicle for teaching the important knowledge and skills children need to learn.

What will it look like?

- Every term or every 4 weeks your child will receive a project based learning challenge.
- There will be lots of opportunities for research and learning about the topic during class time.
- At the end of each project, children will have created a product, or a presentation for their class and teacher.
- If your child is self-isolating you could have them research their topic at home and keep up-to-date with their project!

IMPACT

- Children develop deep content knowledge as well as critical thinking, collaboration, creativity, and communication skills.
