You may be aware that from May 2018, the rules around data protection changed. The 'General Data Protection Regulation' (GDPR) changed how Riverside Primary School/Nursery can use your personal data and that of your child. It has also strengthened your rights over your own data. The purpose of this letter is to seek your consent to use some of your child's personal data, and to share it with our partners, some of whom are detailed below.

During the school/nursery session, a large number of activities take place and we would like to be able to record them on digital images. These images might include your child, and may be displayed on the school website, Twitter feed, printed and displayed in newsletters, on public noticeboards within the school/nursery or be included in the school/nursery news within the Stirling Observer. We see this is a key part of celebrating wider achievement.

We also seek consent for using your contact details to inform you about school/nursery and parent council events, such as social events, trips or excursions, fund raising events, etc. Please note, we do not require consent to contact you about our statutory functions, such as personal support issues about your child, for instance, academic progress and attendance monitoring.

Active Stirling

Young people's data is held in schools within a system called Seemis. This is accessed by the Active Schools team to monitor pupil participation in extra-curricular physical activities. This enables annual reporting to sportsotland to be successfully completed and to use participation data to inform planning of school and community based programs. Data is only used for school activities and will not be used to link to a commercial program through Active Stirling.

Stirling Libraries

Stirling Libraries and Archives Services have 16 libraries from Killin to Strathblane providing services and events. They regularly organise events for children. This can range from class visits from nurseries and schools to after-school, weekend and holiday activities.

Digital Learning

In Stirling Council schools and nurseries, we use a variety of digital tools for learning and teaching, to share information about the life of the school, communicate with parents and carers, and to celebrate success. Use of many of these tools requires sharing some personal data about your child with the providers of the services. This may include, for example, children's names, classes and photographs. For some services, we will need your consent to share personal data.

The parental consent form is on the rear of this letter and I would appreciate if you could complete and return it by Friday 27 September 2019. The information in this form will be used throughout your child's time at school/nursery.
