### REINDEER WEIGHT:

Compare the weight of 5 reindeer:

Prancer: 14kg

Comet: 5kg

Dasher: 15kg

Rudolf: 2kg

Blitzen: 12kg



- Who is the heaviest?
- Who is the lightest?
- Arrange the reindeer from lightest to heaviest.
- **CHALLENGE:** What is the total weight of all of the reindeer

### WINTER BIRDS:

Help the birds by scooping out the inside of an orange and filling it with bird seed.

Watch your bird feeder and count how many birds visit it throughout the day. For an extra challenge, try and make note of all of the different types of birds that visit it.



### WINTER WORD PROBLEMS:

- 1) Mrs MacPhee baked 14 Christmas cookies. Mrs Quintin ate 9 of them, How many cookies did Mrs MacPhee have left?
- 2) There were 6 stockings hanging on the fireplace. The Grinch took 2 pieces of candy from each stocking. How many items did the Grinch take in all?
- 3) There are 8 candy canes to share between 2 friends, how many do they get each?

Remember, you can use counters or items from your home to help you solve the word problems!

Go on a winter scavenger hunt!

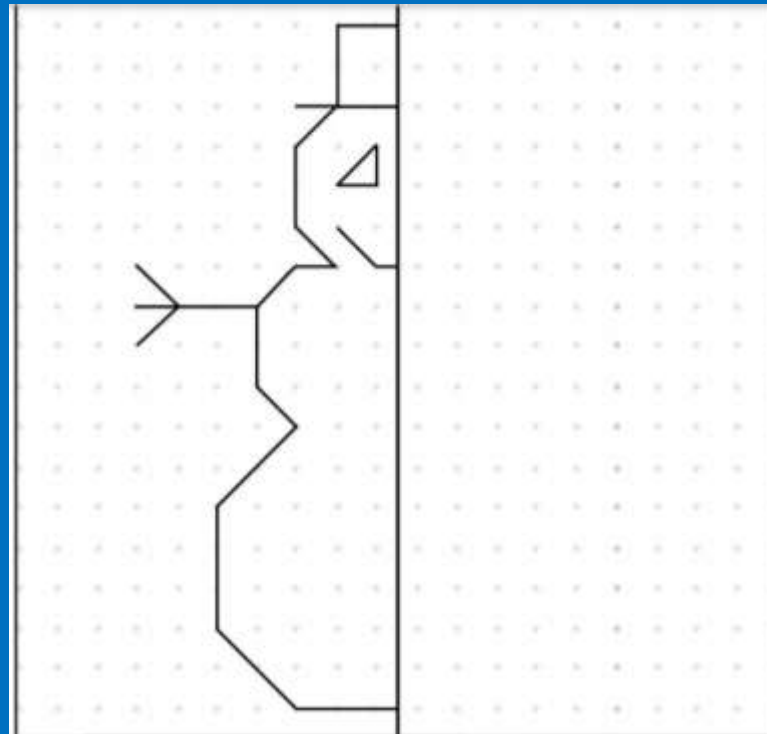
Make a tally chart of all of the items you find.
