Answer these reflective questions about the country you chose:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) What is the population of the country you chose? What do most people do to earn money or survive? Write at least 5 sentences. 2) What is the climate of the country you have chosen? Is it sunny and dry or wet and cold? Write at least 5 sentences. 3) Why did you choose your country? Write at least 5 reasons why the country you chose is special to you. 4) Would you like to live in your chosen country? Explain why or why not. 	<p style="text-align: center;">SPELLING:</p> <p>Spelling Comic! Split your page into 10 sections, and in each section draw a scene of your own spelling comic. Make sure your commentary is in time with the clip!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Numeracy – Times Tables/Division</p> <p>Hit the Button! Play Hit the Button on Topmarks to practice your times tables. Try to challenge yourself with some of the trickier times tables or click on division facts!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Numeracy – Place Value</p> <p>Roll a dice 5 times and record each digit to make a 5 digit number. Then, try to split your number into ten thousands, thousands, hundreds, tens and ones. Finally, write your number out in words. For example: $54,321 = 50,000 + 4,000 + 300 + 20 + 1$ Fifty four thousand, three hundred and twenty one. Repeat this at least 3 times.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Topic</p> <p>The Brain House. Our brains are like houses, where we have an upstairs brain, and a downstairs brain. The little people living in our upstairs brain are our thinkers, they help us to create new things and to problem-solve. The little people living downstairs are our feelers, where they look out for danger and keep us safe. Draw a picture of your own brain house with an upstairs and downstairs, and then try to think of and label at least 3 little people for each floor (for example: Frightened Freddie might live downstairs, whereas Curious Cameron would live upstairs)</p>
