Challenge- video yourself answering one or all the above questions or write down the answers to your questions

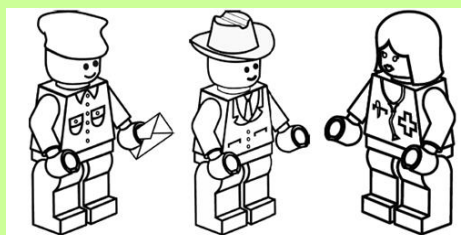
WRITING
