Advice Stirling (Money, Debt & Benefits Advice)

Advice Stirling offers free, confidential and impartial money, debt and benefit advice to citizens within the Stirling area. If you are facing financial difficulty, the team can help complete a full benefits check for you to ensure you have your income fully maximised and assist you to apply for any benefits that have been identified. This includes applying for free school meals and the footwear and clothing grant for your children. The team will also be able to help you draw up a budget and prioritise payments. If you have debts the team can contact and negotiate with your creditors; this includes explaining all options to you for clearing your debts.
