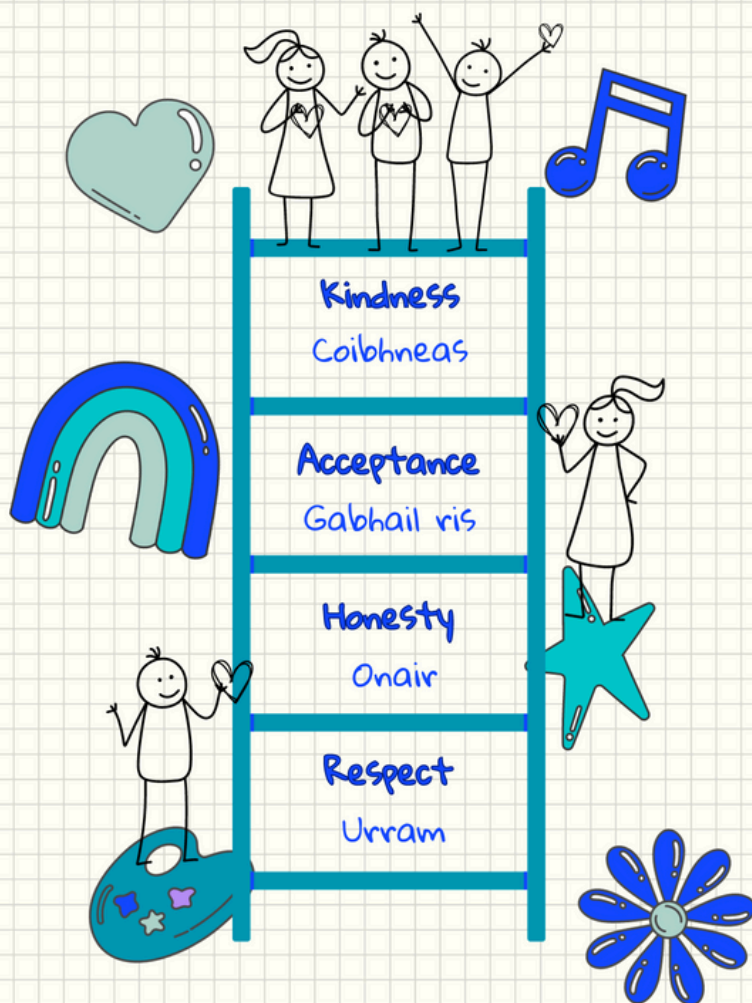

We will continue to host separate Sports Day afternoons for P1-3 and P4-7. This is to ensure ALL children are able to participate fully in each event and activity for their year stage as it was felt that previously this was not possible due to time constraints, timings of the school day and accessibility.

**P1-3 Sports Day will be on Monday 2nd June** (reserve day Monday 9th June).

The children will be walking to the park at 12.45pm and we aim to start the activities by 1pm. P1-3 will be having an early lunch to accommodate this.

**P4-7 Sports Day will be on Monday 26th May** (reserve day Monday 16th June).

We are continuing to hold the event at Riverside Park over two separate events:

School uniform is available to order online via our supplier, 'School Wear Made Easy'.

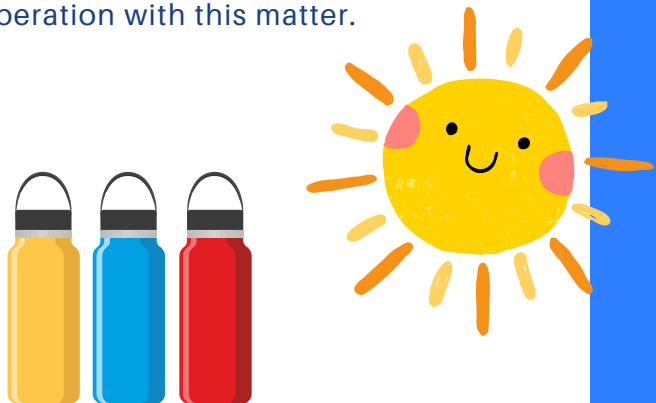
